## Market Development Initiative (MDI)

What is it? The Market Development Initiative (MDI) believes all customers should have access to incentives and education to help complete energy-saving upgrades for their homes and increase their quality of life, regardless of income, socioeconomic status or roadblocks to participating. In Program Year 2023, MDI engaged over 87,000 Ameren Illinois customers through energy efficiency education, discounted energy-efficient products and by providing energy-related jobs and training.
